
SERVICE ON STATIONARY SHIPS AND TRAINS

Note: The residential and business service elements of this item are forborne from regulation in certain Exchanges, as identified in Section 100, Item 4.02. C

1. GENERAL

1.01 Service is furnished on ships in port and on railway cars at stations or other stopping places.

2. REGULATIONS

2.01 The Company provides a telephone with a plug-ended flexible cable that is arranged for connection with a jack-ended channel of a main telephone service, a P.B.X. additional line, and also to a jack-ended channel that extends a main-telephone service. The jack is installed near the designated location of the ship or railway car.

2.02 When service is furnished by a P.B.X. additional line or a channel that extends a main-telephone service, a local-distance (N260-3) applies for the channel.

2.03 Public or semi-public telephone service is furnished in accordance with N150 and N160 respectively.

3. RATES AND CHARGES

3.01 A service charge based on costs, applies for each main-telephone service, each P.B.X. additional line, and to extend a main-telephone service to a ship or railway car and provides for flexible cable and a weather-proof jack. This service charge is in addition to other rates and charges applicable, except that the weather-proof jack is provided without additional charge (N490-8).
