PUBLIC TELEPHONE SERVICE

1. GENERAL

1.01 The Company furnishes public telephone service at its discretion, primarily to make outgoing service available to the general public and determines the location of the service.

2. CONTRACT ARRANGEMENTS

2.01 The occupant of the premises on which service is to be furnished is to sign the standard public telephone service agreement, except when the Company arranges for space and installs public telephones without providing for supervision by the occupant.

3. LISTINGS

3.01 Public telephone services are listed in telephone directories only when the Company considers it necessary for the service in general.

4. EQUIPMENT

- 4.01 Public telephones are equipped with coin-collecting devices except when they are in charge of an attendant.
- 4.02 Regulations about and restrictions on the installation of additional telephones with public telephone service are stated in N220-2.03.

5. RATES AND CHARGES

- 5.01 A rate of \$0.50 applies for each originating local call.
 - 5.02 Regular rates apply for message toll service.
 - 5.03 Service charges associated with the establishment of service and distance charges do not apply. Changes of location and other changes which the Company considers necessary are made without charge; otherwise, service charges apply for the work as stated in N110-3.
