JOINT USE OF SERVICE

1. GENERAL

C 1.01 Joint use of business individual-line service, P.B.X. service, semi-public telephone service is allowed, with the consent of the customer or customer-agent, to persons, firms or corporations not otherwise entitled to it by the terms of this Tariff, whose requirements for telephone service, in the Company's opinion, do not warrant them having their own service.

2. INITIAL SERVICE PERIOD

2.01 The initial service period when the listing of the joint user appears in the directory is the effective period of that directory, except that the charge may be terminated before the end of the directory period upon the conditions specified in N80.

3. REGULATIONS

- 3.01 An application for joint use of service is to be made by the customer or customer-agent, who is responsible for payment of all charges incurred.
- 3.02 The joint user must be located in the same room or suite of rooms as that in which the telephone or the TWX machine is located, and it must be readily accessible to him.
- 3.03 Joint use is not permitted with foreign-exchange service, nor when the customer is engaged primarily in performing secretarial service or is in the business of renting office space to transient or permanent tenants.
- 3.04 No distinctive ringing or signalling arrangement is provided for incoming calls to the joint user.
- C 3.05 Directory listings are provided for the joint user in accordance with N140.
 - 3.06 The Company may limit the number of joint users of any service as necessary to prevent its impairment.

4. RATES AND CHARGES

4.01 The following rates apply for each joint users:

For flat-rate service, the monthly rate is 50% of the basic monthly rate.

4.02 The charge for joint use of service applies from the date on which information records are posted.
